



Overview

Fleetwood was contracted to undertake a full turnkey delivery for Mitchelton Special School that included the design, manufacture, supply and delivery of:

- Six general learning areas
- A staff room
- Home-skills kitchen
- Ambulant toilet along with a shower
- Laundry facilities
- External learning areas
- Connecting walkways
- Stairs and ramps
- Landscape works
- External Structures



Solution

The buildings were constructed over two blocks, each requiring a residential house to be demolished and the land levelled. The site layout, buildings and services designs were undertaken by Fleetwood. With the successful delivery of the project contingent on the collaborative relationship between the relevant stakeholders including Queensland Government's Building and Asset Services and the school board.

Benefits

The buildings were carefully located to ensure clear access from the existing school into the new facilities was achieved. This also allowed for all works to comply with the Disability Discrimination Act and Emergency Egress Compliance, which was critical to the success of the project.
