



We manufacture learning facilities in all states and can swiftly deliver to remote and regional areas. With local operations throughout Australia, we can tailor projects to your needs and get your project installed within days or weeks.

We design and build single learning environments, classrooms, outside school care facilities, through to multistorey permanent buildings for up to 1000 students.

We specialise in permanent modular construction, and also provide temporary and relocatable learning facilities. This helps our clients facing a sudden increase in enrolments, customers with minimal space left on their grounds or centres who are looking to upgrade outdated facilities.









Purpose built relocatable early learning space

Fleetwood was contracted to deliver a design and construct solution for St Johns as part of the Diocese of Toowoomba Catholic Schools expansion plan for the region. Six hours west of Brisbane, St John's Roma is the largest of 31 schools across the Toowoomba Catholic Schools Diocese who have teamed up with Centacare Brisbane to bring this project to fruition.

Fleetwood delivered a fully functional modular kinder, which included open learning areas, amenities, ramps, stairs and storage rooms. In addition to the delivery and installation of the facility, Fleetwood also collaborated with the council in assuring all landscaping and outdoor play areas were completed on schedule.

Solution

The delivery of the St Johns Kindergarten (5 modules), a purpose built relocatable kinder designed specifically for preschool was delivered in a day and fully functional within a week prior to the start of term 3.

The building has provided an additional 30 places for students in the community.

Benefits

The addition of the modular facility has allowed St Johns to run multiple classes for different age groups of preschool children with the new kindergarten and associated Outside School Hours Care service being very well received by the Roma community.

St Johns are now also able to offer families Outside School Hours Care for all primary school students and are now equipped to offer parents world class education from kindergarten right through until Year 12 with the addition of this building.

70 child designer early learning facility

Fleetwood was contracted to design and construct the Maragon Early Learning Centre in Baldivis, WA as part of a full turnkey insitu project. The building is part of a chain of high quality learning centre facilities that is now able to cater to the local community and house over 70 kids at any one time. In an interesting twist, the greenfield site and project scope saw the team take an unconventional approach delivering all aspects of the project from the civils to the structure itself all onsite in a first for Fleetwood.

The collaborative approach between all stakeholders ensured the objective of a fully functional, modern and high quality Early Learning Centre was delivered. The successful delivery of the project allowed the franchise to be sold to a major Australian Childcare provider 'Busy Bees Australia', with the facility adding to their national presence specifically within Perth, Western Australia as it looked to consolidate its national presence with several other childcare facilities across the country.









Transforming unused school grounds into new learning and play areas

Albany Hills State School's P&C approached Fleetwood Australia to provide a full turnkey design and construct solution for their brandnew Outside School Hours Cares (OSHC) facility. The school sought to move OSHC services into a dedicated space to allow them to refurbishment and repurpose the current OSHC building, as well as regain access to classroom spaces previously used by the service.

The location of the new OSHC building was chosen to transform previously unused school grounds, as well as situate the new facility adjacent to the school hall / auditorium. The auditorium is also utilised by the OSHC service, allowing the kids to play and learn in as much space within the school as possible.









High quality child and family centre

Fleetwood was contracted to manufacture and install a Child and Family Centre for the City of Whittlesea. The single storey building is environmentally sustainable and houses three early learning centre playrooms plus maternal and child health service ancillary facilities.

The bespoke design was achieved through a collaborative effort between the client, architect, building surveyor and civil works consultants. The modern design features a high standard of fit out with tailor-made fittings and fixtures as a result of over 30 modules (1050m2) being manufactured and delivered to site.

Solution

The single storey building houses three early learning centre playrooms, a maternal health centre and ancillary facilities. The bespoke design was achieved through a collaborative effort between the client, architect, building surveyor and civil works consultants.

The project resulted in over 30 modules being manufactured in Fleetwood's Bendigo facility and delivered to the project site with building now being leased by the council to a third-party child care operator.

Benefits

The collaborative approach between all stakeholders and consultants ensured the objective of a fully functional, modern and high quality early education facility was achieved. The City of Whittlesea and the current tenants have benefited from a high standard fitout with bespoke fittings and fixtures for the local community to also enjoy.

The flexibility of going with a modular solution has allowed the council to potentially relocate the facility in the future as the demographics of the area change, which will extend the life of the building.









Fleetwood was contracted to deliver a design and construct solution for the Wyndham City Council as part of the municipality's growth strategy over the coming years. The Wyndham Council required a new facility fully operational by the start of the 2018 school year to accommodate an influx of children to the area. Fleetwood delivered a fully functional modular kinder, which included open learning areas, amenities, ramps, stairs, storage rooms and staff administration facilities. In addition to the delivery and installation of the facility, Fleetwood also collaborated with the council in assuring all landscaping and outdoor play areas were completed on schedule.

The Wyndham City Council is now able to run multiple classes for different age groups of preschool children out of the modular facility. With a high standard fit out and bespoke fittings and fixtures for the local community to also enjoy. The flexibility of going with a modular solution has allowed the council to potentially relocate the facility in the future as the demographics of the area change, which will extend the life of the building.
